**Futures and options**—Global financial and commodity futures information for 42 regulated exchanges across 30 countries, with history as far back as 1976. Over 1,110 options contracts are covered across Eurex, Euronext, Austria, Italy, Spain, Sweden, Hong Kong and U.S. markets. More than 750,000 options series include over 212,825 live options series and 540,352 expired series.
