Building on the success and history of the CRB Index, a variant has been created for investors and analysts requiring no exposure to Energy.

COMPONENT COMMODITIES

The TR/J CRB Ex-Energy Index removes Crude Oil, Heating Oil, Natural Gas and RBOB Gasoline from the standard TR/J CRB Index.

The index is comprised of 15 commodities:

Aluminum, Cocoa, Coffee, Copper, Corn, Cotton, Gold, Lean Hogs, Live Cattle, Nickel, Orange Juice, Silver, Soybeans, Sugar and Wheat.

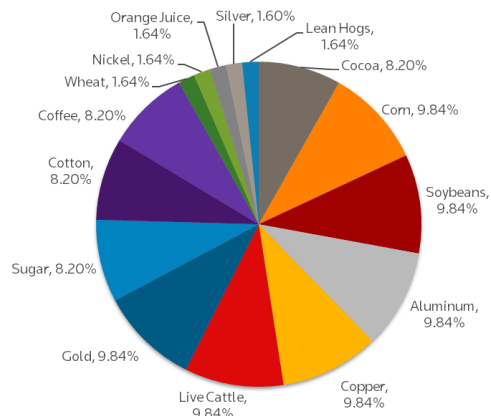
HISTORY

Founded in 1957, the CRB Index has a long history as the most widely followed index of commodities futures. As markets have evolved, the CRB has undergone periodic updates – the latest occurring in 2005. Updates included:

- **COMPONENT CHANGES:** Over the years, commodities including eggs, oats, lard, rubber, potatoes and wool have been dropped and replaced by more liquid and significant contracts.
