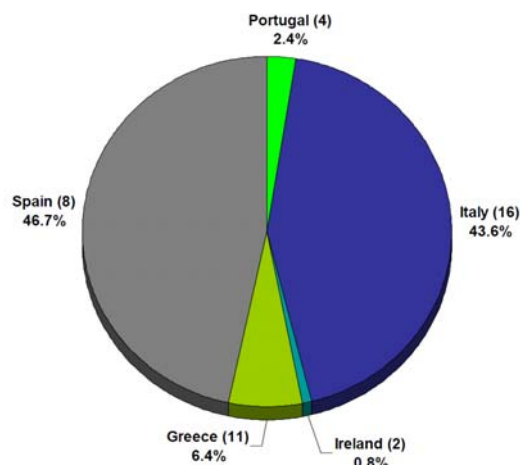

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF CONSTITUENTS

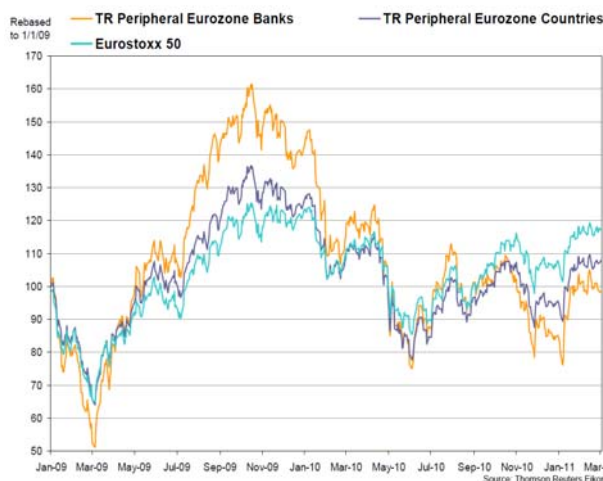
