- Create a team skills assessment on AI benefits
- Implement a training program based on skill gaps

Responsibility

To build trust in AI, over 60% of respondents believe human reviews and data security are considered vital for responsible AI use.

- Conduct a security audit
 - Establish AI principles for ethical AI usage
- Monitor AI updates and regulations

Productivity

Despite working full weeks, 54% of professionals feel they do not have enough time to achieve everything in their role. With AI timesavings, almost 200 hours per person could be freed up in 2025.

- Scale AI integrations with ongoing tracking for long-term success
